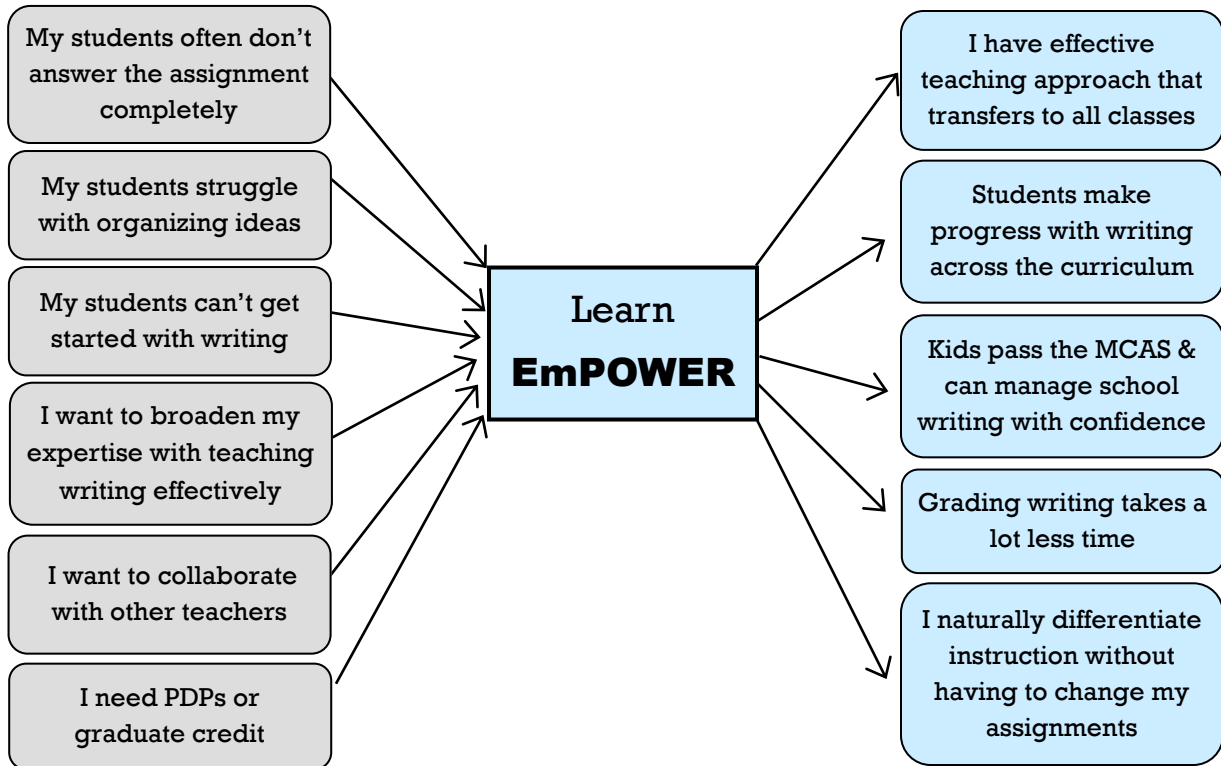

Writing then takes its rightful place for both teachers and students as a vehicle for inquiry, higher-level thinking, and learning.
